Dr. Anna Ślęzak is a graduate of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering at the Częstochowa University of Technology, as well as the Faculty of Economics and Sociology at the University of Łódź and the University of Economics in Krakow. In 2023, she defended her doctoral thesis at the Faculty of Environmental Engineering and Energy at the Tadeusz Kościuszko University of Technology in Krakow in the scientific discipline of environmental engineering, mining, and energy.

Anna Ślęzak has 30 years of professional experience in the energy and business sectors. She began her career at Zakład Energetyczny Łódź Teren S.A., where she served as Deputy Director of the Energy Region in Belchatów and was responsible for the proper operation of the distribution network in the cities of Łódź, Zgierz, and Pabianice, as well as neighboring municipalities and the areas of the former Zakład Energetyczny Łódź Teren. She also worked at the Energy Regulatory Office in Warsaw in the Department of Energy Efficiency and Cogeneration as an advisor to the President of the Energy Regulatory Office, and at the Ministry of Climate and Environment, where she was involved in the implementation of the Fit for 55 package of directives into Polish law.

In August 2024, she took up the position of General Director at PGE Dystrybucja in the Łódź Branch, which covers the Łódź Province and parts of the Świętokrzyskie, Mazowieckie, Śląskie, and Wielkopolskie Provinces.

In his daily practice, he combines technical and economic knowledge. He also holds:
